Medication & Medical Supply Donation Acceptance Guidelines

Thank you for thinking of us at the Chippewa Valley Free Clinic!

Because of our limited services, storage, and safety precautions, we only able to accept the following medical supply donations:

- INSULIN & INHALERS – must be unopened and sealed with a foil cover, in a blister pack, or other anti-tamper container, clean and in good shape and with an expiration date of 6 months or more
- Unused insulin pens tips
- Unused Sharps Containers
- Feminine hygiene supplies such as tampons and sanitary napkins

We are NOT able to use or accept the following items:

- Pills of any kind – opened or unopened
- Syringes of any kind
- Narcotic medications
- Syringes pre-loaded with medication (i.e. Lovenox)
- Blood testing machines or strips
- IV medications
- Orthopedic supplies – braces, boots, immobilizers etc.
- Walkers
- Crutches
- Bath seats
- Sleep apnea machines (CPAP / Bi-PAP) or tubing
- Nebulizers or tubing
- Catheter supplies
- Diapers or colostomy supplies
- Wound dressing supplies
- Rolled bandages & First Aid supplies
- Nutritional drinks such as Ensure, Osmolite, or Carnation Instant Breakfast
- Large medical supply items such as beds
