Our Patients

Over 54 percent of the individuals who utilize these services are employed. However, many are underemployed due to the seasonality or part-time nature of their work and therefore have no health care coverage. Many must support other family members. Managing their illnesses allows individuals to better function in their daily responsibilities.

The Chippewa Valley Free Clinic's mission is to provide quality health care to and advocacy for individuals of the Chippewa Valley area who have no reasonable health care alternative.

Your contributions not only aid the individuals directly served, but the community-at-large.

Your contributions will:

- 1) Allow the most fragile and vulnerable members of society to receive basic health care with dignity and respect. Our patients are adults with an income less than 200% of the Federal Poverty Guideline and do not have private or government provided medical coverage.
- 2) Provide acute and chronic care at a much lower per treatment cost than traditional medical facilities. (The services and medications are provided at no cost to the patient.)
- 3) Allow local hospital emergency departments and urgent care units to serve as they were designed to attend to the most critical patients, while the Free Clinic attends to common illnesses and chronic care such as diabetes, hypertension, hyperlipidemia, asthma, and vision care.
- 4) Provide access to basic medical care which is considered a fundamental human right.
