

Medication & Medical Supply

Donation Acceptance Guidelines

Because of our limited services, storage, and safety precautions, we only able to accept the following medical supply donations:

- INHALERS – must be unopened and sealed with a foil cover, in a blister pack, or other anti-tamper container, clean and in good shape and with an expiration date of 6 months or more
- Feminine hygiene supplies such as tampons and sanitary napkins
- Incontinence products such as pull-up briefs and pads

We are NOT able to use or accept the following items:

- Pills of any kind – opened or unopened
- Syringes of any kind
- Narcotic medications
- Syringes pre-loaded with medication (i.e. Lovenox)
- Insulin
- Unused insulin pens tips
- Unused Sharps Containers
- Blood testing machines or strips
- IV medications
- Orthopedic supplies – braces, boots, immobilizers etc.
- Walkers
- Crutches
- Bath seats
- Sleep apnea machines (CPAP / Bi-PAP) or tubing
- Nebulizers or tubing
- Catheter supplies
- Diapers or colostomy supplies
- Wound dressing supplies
- Rolled bandages & First Aid supplies
- Nutritional drinks such as Ensure, Osmolite, or Carnation Instant Breakfast
- Large medical supply items such as beds
